Report to Stibbard Parish Council AGM 2025

Financially, it was a good year with a small trading profit of £391 being recorded – the first for many years. This was partly due to there being two elections during the year which was beneficial to the hall as it is the village polling station. Conversely, 2025 will probably not show a profit because there are no elections this year.

A number of private lettings throughout the year, together with our regular groups, contributed to the hall income.
